It gives me immense pleasure to address you all on this wonderful occasion as we celebrate the Founder's Day of Seva Sadan Central School. As Principal of this institution, I present before you a brief report covering the outstanding achievements and activities of the institution during the academic year 2022-2023.

Seva Sadan Central School currently runs with a strength of 800 students. It has been able to make its presence felt in academic as well as co-curricular areas at the Inter school, State and National levels. In the All India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination 2022, our School came out with 100% pass. Nandana P R scored 93% and became the topper in Science stream and Pranav M Nair scored 85% and became the topper in Commerce stream. In the All India Secondary School Examination 2022 Our School came out with 100% pass and secured 24 Distinctions and 8 First Class. The School topper Abhishek P secured 95% marks. He also secured 100% marks in Malayalam and 99% in Science. Shreya Madambath secured 99% marks in English.

As part of **Reading Day** 2022 programme on June 19th, our students of various classes lighted **Aksharadeepam**. They presented various programmes in the School Assembly. A **Literary Club** was also inaugurated on the same day.

Environment day celebrations were conducted in the month of June; Various Drawing and painting competitions were held on the day. The highlight of celebration was the enthusiasm shown by our students in donating and planting saplings in the school campus.

As a part of our effort to upgrade, the teaching skills and knowledge of the faculty a subject enrichment programme for teachers, **'Eglestia'** was conducted on June 18th, which has immensely benefited our faculty.

June 27th was celebrated as **Anti Drug Day** at the school and a **Health Club** was inaugurated to mark the day.

In addition a **Social Science Club** was also inaugurated on July 2nd.

A collection of poems compiled by students of various classes titled ' **Stream Of Thoughts'** was released in the school assembly on August 1st.

An Orientation for class VI to XII was organized by **KBS ACADEMY Palakkad** during the month of September to give an awareness about preparing for Medical & Engineering Entrance examinations.

Our Students from 4th Standard to 12th Standard participated in CBSE Expression Series 2022 Competitions I, II & III .

Our students from VI to XII also participated in Veergatha Project, Budding Author Programme, and Reading Challenge conducted by CBSE.

Our students participated in **Sankalap**-PDSSC Sahodaya held on Oct 04th at St.Raphael's School, Palakkad. **Pavithra C Nair** of class X

secured first position in Malayalam Versification, Srihari P of Class X secured second position in Painting and Sreehith P of Class VI secured third position in Cartoon Drawing.

Our students also took part in JSKA Kerala State School Open Karate Championship. Ajul Krishna of Class IV secured the second position in the event.

Our students also participated in CBSE State Kalolsav held at Carmel School Vazhakkulam, Ernakulam on Nov 30th. **Pavitra C Nair** of Class X secured **A grade** in Malayalam Versification and **Sreehith P** of Class VI secured **C grade** in Cartoon Drawing.

National Mathematics day - **IPSO FACTO** was celebrated at the school on 22 Dec and various activities were organised to commemorate the day.

Annual Sports Meet was organised and students across the classes participated with zeal and vigour.

As a part of planned adventure activity, a tour of students of class X and class XII was organised to Ooty on Dec 24th.

The school also observed days like International Yoga Day, International Day against Drug Abuse, Independence Day, Hindi Day, Hiroshima Day, Teachers Day, Vijaya Dasami etc with various programmes like skits, speeches and Poster Making Competitions.

Various Literary, Dance, Music and Arts competitions were held at the school level. The students of all the classes participated in the competitions with great enthusiasm.

Our institution is very keen in developing the artistic talents of students. We give them training in Bharata Natyam, Guitar, Keyboard, Classical Music, karate and Chenda. Yoga training for the students of classes 3 to 10 is also given by an experienced Yoga trainer.

I am happy to announce that our school YouTube video channel launched in the year 2018 is very popular and getting many views. The performance and activities of our students are recorded and posted on the channel regularly.

Our school has always extended special care to students who are academically struggling. We are offering Special Coaching every Saturday to the students of 1st to 5th Stds and on all evenings to the students of 6th to 10th Stds to improve their performance particularly in Mathematics and English. A Mathematics Clinic is also working in the Institution to give strong foundation on Mathematics and to provide coaching for needy students .

We are continuing with the system of ICT enabled Classroom teaching i.e. the Smart Class Programme in our school which was started 11 years back. It helps the students to easily grasp the subjects they have to study.

Apart from providing a good environment for improving the academic standards of our students and developing their talents, Seva Sadan Central School has also taken special care to instill in them human values like charity, compassion and mercy.
