With your permission, I now present the Annual Report of the academic year 2024-25.

Seva Sadan Central School has been stepping from success to success all through the years since its humble beginning in 1978 and the past year has been no exception. We have done excellently in academics and non-academic areas. At present the School has a total strength of 681 students and 70 staff including non-teaching staff.

# Praveshanolsavam -

The new academic session commenced on 01<sup>st</sup> June 2024. Our School campus was once again sketched with colourful rainbows of vibrant children after the summer break. A Special assembly was conducted to welcome the students.

Academic Excellence: The system of education in our school is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to meet the needs of New Education Policy. Results of AISSE and AISSCE 2023-24 are a proven specimen for this. 29 students of class X and 18 students of class XII appeared in the AISSE and AISSCE conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education in March 2024. Our School came out with 100% pass. Out of 18 students from class XII, 9 students secured distinction and 9 students secured first class. Kumari K S Arya scored 89.6 % and became the topper in Science stream and Abhishek Koilathumpadi scored 89.2 % and became the topper in Commerce stream. Out of 29 students of class X, 19 students secured distinction, 9 students first class and one student secured second class. Kumari Sreya K C and Master C P Govind Krishna became toppers by securing 93.4%

### **KG SECTION**

Classes of UKG and LKG for the academic year began on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> June respectively. Children were welcomed by distributing sweets and cards. We started Pre KG in this academic year and was inaugurated by Dr.Sadanam Harikumar on 12<sup>th</sup> June.

Brain gym activities are conducted to improve their concentration and memory. Activities in class include discussion, colouring, art work, cut and paste, collage works, thumb printing, drawing with magical strokes and model making. All these activities help children to acquire different skills in visual, listening, language, early mathematical skills, manipulative, concept of position, direction, time and texture emotion etc

Nature walks helps children to develop many skills, understand new concepts, inculcate values, appreciate nature and be proud of their culture and tradition. The first nature walk was a walk around the campus. Children were taken around the school to know their way to their classrooms through different corridors

Children enjoyed a visit to nearby Post Office and posted letter to their Grant Parents.
